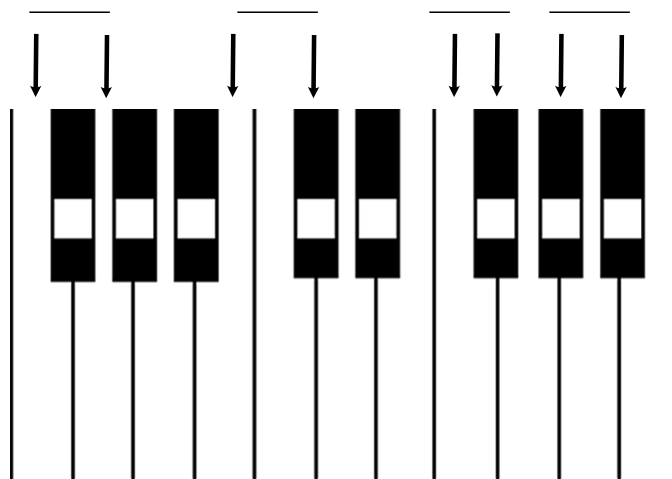
II. Keyboard Identification:
